

## **Foothills Christian Church Reopening FAQ's Updated August 2020**

### **For Staff and Volunteers:**

Staff and Volunteers will not serve if they are sick.

Facial Coverings mandatory if within 6 feet of others.

Volunteers and staff will maintain a 6 feet distance between one another and any visitor.

Bathrooms will be disinfected frequently.

Counter tops, Doorknobs, handles and common areas will be disinfected frequently.

Hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout the campus.

### **For Church Attendees:**

Services will be held outdoors in the church parking lot between the main sanctuary building and the middle school building.

We advise you dress according to the weather forecast. The area is shaded once service begins.

All Attendees who are at risk, sick, or immunocompromised are encouraged to stay home and attend services online.

All Attendees must wear facemasks until they are seated.

There will be 2 outdoor services provided: Saturday 7 pm and Sunday 7 pm.

Rows are set up 6 feet apart from each other. Attendees in the same household will be allowed to sit together and requested to maintain a social distance from others.

Childcare will be available for 5 years and under.

Jr High services will be held outdoors in the church courtyard area during Saturday and Sunday services.

High School M910 services will be held outdoors in a secured area on the west side of the parking lot during Sunday services.

Signs will be posted throughout the campus to remind Attendees of the six feet apart protocol and to wear facemasks.

Attendees have various giving options: Electronically on the Foothills App, and Website, in person there will be no offering plates. There will be an Offering Dropbox at each exit.

After service all attendees will be asked to exit without congregating in the service areas.
